Current conditions on Hard Road - Phase A segment

Hard Road – Phase A, Sawmill Road to just west of Smoky Row Road

Description and Benefits: Phases A, B and C will widen Hard Road from two lanes to five between Sawmill Road and State Route 315. Phase A is approximately 1.2 miles in length. Planned improvements include curbs, gutters, sidewalks, street lighting, storm sewer, traffic signals, signs, pavement markings and bike lanes. With an increase in residential development, widening of arterial Hard Road was deemed necessary in order to decrease traffic congestion and facilitate its movement, provide pedestrians and bicyclists with a safer pathway and improve infrastructure of corridor.
