## RiverSouth - Phase 2

**Description and Benefits:** The RiverSouth project will fulfill Mayor Michael B. Coleman's vision to bring a community feel to this important downtown neighborhood by upgrading aging utilities; resurfacing; adding new street lights, improving signs and signals; adding "green" bio-retention planters and landscaping as well as amenities such as benches, bike racks, granite curbs and brick crosswalks/sidewalks to encourage residents and downtown workers to walk, relax and enjoy the area. The improvements will revitalize the area and provide for economic growth and development. Overall, the conversion to two-way traffic along with additional landscaping and designated bike routes will provide traffic calming that will encourage a safer, more inviting environment for bicyclists, scooter operators and pedestrians.

### Schedule:

Construction start - September 2009; completion - October 2011. Two-way traffic conversion between Rich and Mound on Front Street - summer 2011.
